

Engler strikes accord with Lowell Rotary

**** Michigan governor raises interesting political discussion on new way to determine school districts' state aid.

There was a premium put on attendance at the weekly Lowell Rotary luncheon.

The 185 present made it one of the largest attended service club luncheons ever.

In attendance was the club's guest speaker, former Future Farmer of America member, and currently and most prominently the gov-

ernor of Michigan - John Engler.

The Michigan native son embraced the idea of using schools' average daily attendance to determine their state aid.

"This way, there are no ifs, ands or buts," Gov. Engler said. "The premium would be put on attendance."

Engler brought up the idea when questioned about the inequity of growing school districts not being funded in the first year for each new student. Currently, schools receive funds for a blended count (an average of the spring and fall student counts or about half of the increase).

"School district growth is not always fully recognized in the first year, but it is in the second year," Engler said.

In part, this is because the state has determined districts with declining enrollment are worse off and should be addressed that first year.

"I have been told by school administrators it is more difficult to deal with declining enrollments than rising enrollments," Engler said.

The governor also spoke of public education and the need for its rapid improvement. He warned people not to misinterpret that statement.

Cherry Creek students help fill volunteer need for popcorn operation

Long before the smell permeates throughout the Cherry Creek Elementary building, students from the rooms of Kim VanBelois and Pam Kinnucan are busy scooping, popping and bagging popcorn for its 700-plus customers.

It is a service the two classrooms volunteered to undertake.

"With more students than ever in Cherry Creek, more and more volunteers are needed," VanBelois said. "The PTO was having difficulty finding volunteers."

The service/learning project provides students an opportunity to work within and assist its school community.

"The kids have taken a lot of pride in what they are doing and it is providing them with life and academic skills," VanBelois said.

The students provide this service to the building teachers, administrators and fellow students on an every other Friday basis.

Along with popping, bagging and delivering, students are also in charge of advertising their product,

collecting 25 cents for each bag delivered, and sorting and counting the money.

"They are also keeping



graphs to show how many students purchased popcorn," VanBelois said.

Justin Bogdanik, a fifthgrader in Kinnucan's class, is one of the students who sorts and counts the money. "We've been making over \$100 every Friday we've sold popcorn,"he explains. "We're selling a lot of bags."

All the proceeds go back to the PTO (owners of the popcorn machine). In turn, the PTO uses the money to do things for the school.

"It has given the kids a feeling of importance - that they are making a difference," Kinnucan said.

That was re-emphasized in a letter the classrooms received from Cherry Creek principal, Bill Markovich.

The service/learning project requires four-five hours from the students every other week. If the job is to be completed successfully, it also requires cooperation, common sense, courtesy, caring and consideration.

"The kids feel good about what they are doing. These kids also need hands-on activities," VanBelois said.
