Tubay is a coastal municipality in the province of **Agusan del Norte**.

The municipality has a land area of 138.09 square kilometers or 53.32 square miles which constitutes 5.06% of Agusan del Norte's total area. Its population as determined by the 2015 Census was 24,932. This represented 7.03% of the total population of Agusan del Norte province, or 0.96% of the overall population of the **Caraga** region. Based on these figures, the population density is computed at 181 inhabitants per square kilometer or 468 inhabitants per square mile.

Population by age group

According to the 2015 Census, the age group with the highest population in Tubay is *5 to 9*, with 2,983 individuals. Conversely, the age group with the lowest population is *80 and over*, with 150 individuals.

▼ details

Combining age groups together, those aged *14 and below*, consisting of the the young dependent population which include infants/babies, children and young adolescents/teenagers, make up an aggregate of 35.54% (8,862). Those aged *15 up to 64*, roughly, the economically active population and actual or potential members of the work force, constitute a total of 60.08% (14,978). Finally, old dependent population consisting of the senior citizens, those aged *65 and over*, total 4.38% (1,092) in all.

The computed **Age Dependency Ratios** mean that among the population of Tubay, there are 59 youth dependents to every 100 of the working age population; there are 7 aged/senior citizens to every 100 of the working population; and overall, there are 66 dependents (young and old-age) to every 100 of the working population.

The **median age** of 22 indicates that half of the entire population of Tubay are aged less than 22 and the other half are over the age of 22.

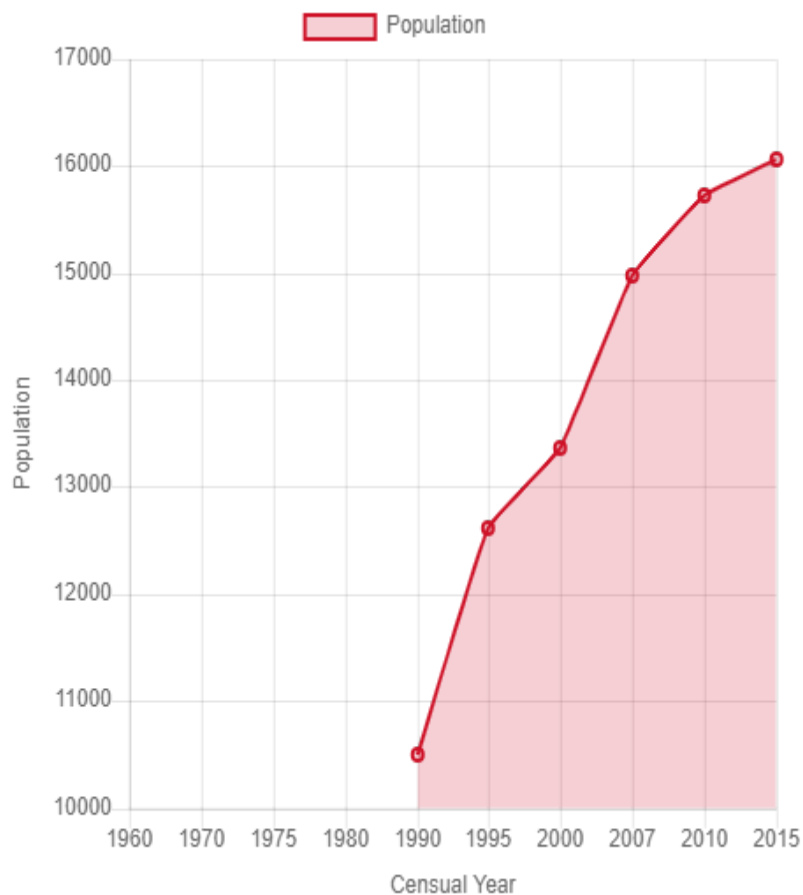

Historical population

The population of Remedios T. Romualdez grew from 10,490 in 1990 to 16,058 in 2015, an increase of 5,568 people. The latest census figures in 2015 denote a positive growth rate of 0.39%, or an increase of 323 people, from the previous population of 15,735 in 2010.

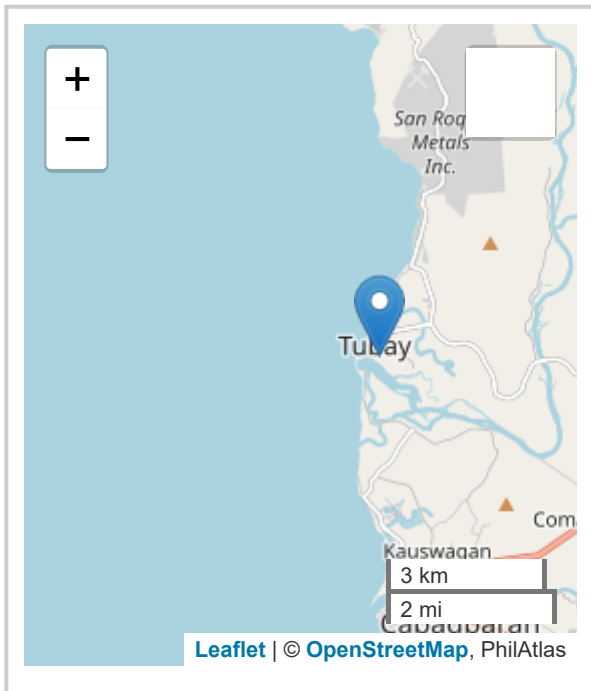


Population

Growth Rate

Location

The municipal center of Tubay is situated at approximately 9° 10' North, 125° 31' East, in the island of Mindanao. Elevation at these coordinates is estimated at 10.1 meters or 33.0 feet above mean sea level.



Distances

Based on the *great-circle distance* (the shortest distance between two points over the surface of the Earth), the cities closest to Tubay are **Cabadbaran**, **Butuan**, **Bayugan**, **Gingoog**, **Surigao City**, and **Tandag**. The nearest municipalities are **Santiago**, **Remedios T. Romualdez**, **Magallanes**, **Jabonga**, **Buenavista**, and **Nasipit**. Its distance from the national capital is 777.80 kilometers (483.30 miles). The following list delineates such distance measurements.
