### NOTABLES

- The Billikens' non-conference season concludes on Wednesday night when they take on the NC State Wolfpack in Raleigh. The Billikens will be off for two weeks before opening A-10 play Wed., Jan. 3, 2024, against Loyola Chicago at Chaifetz Arena.
- Saint Louis has won two in a row, including a thrilling 75-74 win against Louisiana Tech the last time out in what will forever be known as the **"Terrence Hargrove Jr. Game."** The fifth-year senior scored 11 straight points in the final :28 seconds, including the buzzer-beating, game-winning 3-pointer, to lift SLU to the improbable comeback win and send Chaifetz Arena fans into a frenzy.
- Guard **Gibson Jimerson** has scored 20+ points in five of the last six games. With a game-high 23 points and four 3s against LA Tech, he moved to ninth on SLU's all-time scoring list and second all-time in career 3s.
- **Bradley Ezewiro** made his debut last Saturday, 24 hours after the NCAA and US District courts deemed two-time transfers immediately eligible. He finished with 17 points on 6-9 shooting and corralled five boards.
- **Terrence Hargrove Jr.** leads the Billikens with 6.3 rpg.
- Leading scorer **Sincere Parker** (17.3 ppg) is out 4-6 weeks after suffering a foot injury against Wyoming on Nov. 16.
- The Bills lead the A-10 in free-throws made per game (16.5). They are second in the league and 16th in the NCAA in 3FG% (.392).

## WHAT'S ON TAP?

- Saint Louis (7-5) plays its final game of the non-conference season on Wednesday night, facing the NC State Wolfpack at PNC Arena in Raleigh, North Carolina.
- Following Wednesday's matchup, the Bills have a much-needed two-week break before opening Atlantic 10 Conference play at home against Loyola Chicago on Wednesday, Jan. 3, 2024. SLU has had several nagging injuries throughout the non-conference season, so the break for the holidays comes at an opportune time.

## FOLLOWING THE ACTION

- Wednesday's game will not be televised, but it will be streamed on ACC Network Extra as well as ESPN+.
- Burch Antley** and **Scott Wood** have the call.
- KMOX 1120 AM serves as the Home for Billiken Basketball on the radio. Billiken Hall of Famers and longtime SLU men's basketball radio partners **Bob Ramsey** and **Earl Austin Jr.** will call the action for all SLU games, both at home and on the road.

## LAST TIME OUT

- **Terrence Hargrove Jr.** scored Saint Louis' last 11 points in the final 28 seconds, including a buzzer-beating 3-pointer, and the Billikens overcame a late deficit to defeat Louisiana Tech 75-74 Saturday night at Chaifetz Arena.
- SLU improved to 7-5 with its second straight victory. Louisiana Tech of Conference USA – which did not commit a turnover – slipped to 9-3.
- **Gibson Jimerson** scored a game-high 23 points, including 4-of-7 from beyond the arc. Jimerson took sole possession of second place on SLU's career 3-point field goals made list with 263 -- breaking a tie with **Kevin Lisch** -- and passed **Dwayne Evans** for ninth place on the Billikens' career points list with 1,505.
- **Bradley Ezewiro** (6-of-9 FG) tallied 17 points, just two shy of his career high, and five rebounds in his Billiken debut.
- Hargrove finished with 13 points on 5-of-6 shooting (2-of-3 from distance), while Cian Medley contributed career highs of 10 points and seven assists (game high). **Bruce Zhang** grabbed a career-high seven rebounds, and **Tim Dalger** collected six boards.
- The Billikens shot 54 percent (27-of-50) from the floor overall and 55.6 percent (10-of-18) from 3-point range. SLU is 23-of-47 (48.9 percent) in 3-point shooting over its last two games.

## JUST.... HOW?

- Here's a closer look at those final 28 seconds against LA Tech when **Terrence Hargrove Jr.** scored 11 straight points to power the Bills to the win...
  - Down by 6, Hargrove converted a spectacular driving dunk that turned into a three-point play bringing SLU within 3 at the 28-second mark.
  - LA Tech went 1-of-2 from the foul line, putting SLU down by 4. Hargrove drove for a layup with 17 seconds left, making it a 2-point game at that point.
  - LA Tech again went 1-of-2 from the foul line, putting SLU down by 3. Hargrove tied the game with a 3-pointer from the right wing with six seconds left.
  - LA Tech was fouled in the Billiken backcourt, and they hit both of their free throws to go up by two. The Billikens in-bounded the ball with 5.1 seconds remaining. Hargrove took it all the way up the court and buried a deep 3-pointer from the left wing. The buzzer sounded just before the ball entered the basket, giving SLU the thrilling 75-74 win at Chaifetz Arena.
- It was the Billikens' first buzzer-beater since **Yuri Collins'** running floater at the double-overtime buzzer lifted SLU to a 92-90 win at George Mason on Feb. 2, 2022. It was the second buzzer-beater for the Bills in Chaifetz Arena history (**Mike Crawford**, 76-74 2OT, 2/1/17 vs. George Mason).

## ABOUT THE WOLFPACK

- NC State enters Wednesday's action 7-3 overall. The three losses came against BYU (No. 5 KenPom), Ole Miss (No. 90 KenPom) and Tennessee (No. 7 KenPom).
- The Wolfpack already played an ACC game, winning at Boston College Dec. 2 in overtime, 84-78. That is NC State's best win according to KenPom's ratings, as Boston College checks in at No. 93.
- **Jayden Taylor**, a transfer from Butler, is leading the Wolfpack with 14.3 ppg. **DJ Horne** and **DJ Burns Jr.** both average double figures in scoring and are both over 1,500+ career points.
- NC State has had balanced scoring. The Wolfpack have had 10 different players reach double figures in scoring in a game this year.
- The Wolfpack are 15th in the NCAA in fastbreak points per game (16.8) and rank 19th in the country in turnover margin (4.3).

## SERIES HISTORY

► This will be the third meeting between the Wolfpack and Billikens. SLU leads the series 2-0 It's the return game of a home-and-home series that was quickly scheduled during the 2020-21 COVID season. The Billikens won that game on Dec. 17, 2020, 80-69, at Chaifetz Arena.

► SLU defeated NC State in the first round of the 2014 NCAA Championship in Orlando, rallying from 16 down with eight minutes to play to win 83-80 in overtime.

## TRACKING JIMERSON

► **Gibson Jimerson** has scored in double figures in eight straight games and is averaging 16.8 ppg for the Billikens.

► SLU's leading scorer each of the last two seasons, he is working his way up several categories in the SLU record book. He is ninth all-time in career scoring and second in career 3s.

► Among all active NCAA Division players, Jimerson is 64th in career points, 26th in career 3s made and 33rd in career 3FG%.

► Last season, Jimerson led the Billikens with 14.0 ppg and was second in the A-10 in 3FG percentage (85-212, .401) and third in the league in 3-pointers made per game (2.58).

► Jimerson announced on March 29 his intention to return to the Billikens. In fact, while this is Jimerson's fifth season with the Billikens, he is technically a junior eligibility wise. He received a medical hardship waiver his first season (2019-20) after injuring his foot after playing in 10 games, the maximum amount of games allowed for him to play in and still receive the waiver. The 2020-21 season did not count against a players' eligibility due to the pandemic.

► Dec. 17, 2022, was a special day for Jimerson. In the morning, he walked across the stage at Chaifetz Arena in a cap and gown during SLU's Midyear Commencements and received a B.S. in International Business. Later that night in a game against Drake in the same Chaifetz Arena, he registered his 1,000th career point. Jimerson was named an Academic All-American in 2021-22.

## HARGROVE IS SLU'S TOP REBOUNDER

► **Terrence Hargrove Jr.** is averaging 14.1 ppg and a team-leading 6.3 rpg.

► In the game against Hofstra (the game before his heroics against LA Tech), Hargrove scored 19 points, including the go-ahead basket with less than a minute remaining, in the win against Hofstra.

► Hargrove averaged 15 points and 5.7 rebounds in the Myrtle Beach Invitational en route to All-Tournament team honors.

► Back for his fifth season with the Bills, Hargrove has played in 124 games in his career and could surpass the school record for games played this year. That record is currently held by **Dwayne Evans** and **Jordair Jett**, who played in 134 games from 2010-14.

► Last year, Hargrove appeared in all 33 games and made 16 starts. He was third on the Billikens with 20 blocked shots. In A-10 play, Hargrove shot better than 50 percent and averaged 7.7 points and 4.2 rebounds.

► Hargrove was the recipient of the U.S. Basketball Writers Association 2023 Perry Wallace Most Courageous Award for coming forward to discuss his mental health and helping to remove any stigma still associated with that, and to also acknowledge the many issues college basketball players – and athletes in all sports – have faced before, during and after the pandemic.

## WELCOME BRADLEY EZEWIRO

► Junior **Bradley Ezewiro** made his debut on Saturday night against Louisiana Tech, 24 hours after the NCAA's decision to allow all two-time transfers the ability to play this year.

► He did not disappoint, scoring 17 points on 6-of-9 shooting with five rebounds in 18 minutes. Ezewiro played seven games at LSU in 2021-22 and 27 games (seven starts) last year at Georgetown.

► Ezewiro has been in the on-going waiver process this year, so he has been practicing all season with the Billikens.

## DALGER COMES UP BIG VS. HOFSTRA

- Senior **Tim Dalger** scored a season-high 20 points, including 13 in the second half, and dished out a career-high five assists in the win against Hofstra.
- Dalger came off the bench in the Billikens' first three games, but was inserted into the starting lineup against Wyoming in the Myrtle Beach Invitational and has been starting ever since.
- Dalger has scored in double figures in three straight games after he was held scoreless against Utah State.
- Dalger was especially productive in the win against Wyoming when Sincere Parker went down with injury, scoring 17 points and registering three steals.
- For the season, Dalger scores 11.6 ppg and hauls in 4.7 rpg.

## PARKER OUT 4-6 WEEKS WITH FOOT INJURY

- Junior **Sincere Parker** suffered a fracture in his right foot Nov. 16 against Wyoming and is out 4-6 weeks.
- He had a career-best 22 points against the Cowboys and was leading the Billikens with eight boards before leaving with eight minutes left in the second half with the injury.
- Parker's 17.3 ppg this season leads the Billikens.
- Last season, Parker played in all 33 games and averaged 5.9 points and 3.7 rebounds. He shot 42.3 percent from the field and was third on the team with 23 3-pointers made.

## THAMES CONTRIBUTING IN PARKER'S ABSENCE

- Sophomore **Kellen Thames** has appeared in all 12 games off the bench and is averaging 5.6 points and 3.9 rebounds.
- Thames recorded his first-career double-double at Southern Illinois, recording career highs of 10 points and 11 rebounds. Against Drake, he played the majority of the game on a bum ankle and hit all three of his shots from the field, including a trey, for seven points.
- Thames did not disappoint after playing the most substantial minutes of his career in the three games at the Myrtle Beach Invitational. He averaged 7.0 ppg and 4.7 rpg in the three games.

## MEDLEY STARTING AT THE POINT

- The Billikens are starting freshman point guard **Cian Medley** as graduate transfer, **Michael Meadows Jr.**, recovers from a back injury he aggravated against Southern Illinois.
- Medley had his best game as a Billiken Saturday night against LA Tech, scoring a career-high 10 points and dishing out a career-best seven assists.
- Meadows leads the A-10 with a 3.50 assist-turnover ratio. In nine games, he has dished out 28 assists and committed just eight turnovers. There is no timeline on when he will return to the lineup.
- This is the first time in four years that **Yuri Collins** isn't manning the point guard spot at SLU.
- Collins holds every assists record in SLU school history, and is the A-10 career assists leader as well.
- In his four-year Billiken career, he totaled 878 assists and finished with 1,002 career points. He is 22nd in NCAA history in career assists and ranks 16th in NCAA history in assists average.

## FRESH STARTERS

- Saint Louis has started a pair of freshmen the last three games as **Cian Medley** and **Bruce Zhang** were inserted into the starting lineup.
- They are the third pair of freshmen that have started together in the **Travis Ford** era, the others being **Hasahn French** and **Jordan Goodwin** (2017-18), and **Yuri Collins** and **Jimmy Bell Jr.** (2019-20).

## BRUUUUUUUCE ZHANG CONTRIBUTING

- Seven-foot freshman center **Bruce Zhang** made his collegiate debut Nov. 11 against Illinois State. He converted a 3-point play for this first-collegiate points to bring the Chaifetz Arena crowd to its feet.
- Zhang had career highs of nine points and two steals at Drake. He is coming off a career-high seven rebounds against LA Tech.
- Billikens fans are quick to yell "Bruuuuuuce" each time Zhang checks in or scores. It's familiar territory for St. Louis sports fans as they would do the same each time Super Bowl XXXIV champion and NFL Hall of Famer **Isaac Bruce** would catch a pass for St. Louis Rams from 1995-2007.

## BASKETBALL BLOODLINES

- **Larry Hughes II** is the son of Billiken great **Larry Hughes**. Larry Hughes played one season at SLU in 1997-98 before enjoying a long and successful career in the NBA. In his lone season with the Bills, Larry Hughes scored a school record 670 points and led the Bills to an NCAA Tournament appearance. Additionally, Larry Hughes Jr.'s sister, Lauryn, graduated from SLU in 2021 after playing four seasons on the SLU women's

## HOME SWEET CHAIFETZ

► Saint Louis is in its 16th season playing inside the 10,600-seat Chaifetz Arena.  
 ► SLU is 202-69 all-time at Chaifetz Arena, including 6-1 this year.  
 ► Chaifetz Arena is named after SLU alumnus **Dr. Richard A. Chaifetz**. Dr. Chaifetz is a world-renowned entrepreneur and business leader, who in 1984 founded CompPsych Corporation, which today is the world's largest provider of employee assistance programs, behavioral health and wellness services.

## ROAD-TRIPPING

► The Billikens recently completed a rare two-game non-conference road trip at Southern Illinois and at Drake.  
 ► It's the first time in the **Travis Ford** era and the first time since 2013-14 that the Billikens played back-to-back non-conference games on the road. (at SIUE Nov. 13, 2013; at Southern Illinois Nov. 16, 2013).  
 ► Saint Louis is 4-12 in non-conference road games under Ford. The Billikens' last non-conference road win was an 86-82 overtime triumph at Boise State on Nov. 30, 2021. Other non-con road wins under Ford was at Boston College (2019-20), at Kansas State (2019-20) and at Seton Hall (2018-19).

## JIMERSON UP FOR ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICAN

► **Gibson Jimerson**, who graduated with a degree in international business with a GPA above 3.9, was named Academic All-American in 2021-22 and will be up for the award this year as well. It has been a stated goal by Jimerson to earn the prestigious honor this season.  
 ► Other Academic All-Americans in school history are **Rich Niemann** (1968), **Ted Mimitz** (1986), **Scott Highmark** (1994 & 1995), **Kevin Lisch** (2009) and **Brian Conklin** (2012).

## REMEMBERING FORD STUEN

► The Billikens remember and honor assistant coach **Ford Stuen**, who passed away May 11, 2021, at the age of 29. Stuen, the nephew of head coach **Travis Ford**, played at Oklahoma State for his uncle and served on the Billikens' staff for five years.  
 ► SLU players wear a patch on their jersey with the "FS" script. That is how Stuen would sign his name on the many hand-written notes and letters that he would send to family, friends, and coaching colleagues.  
 ► On opening night, Nov. 9, 2021, a banner was unveiled honoring **Ford Stuen** that will forever hang in the Chaifetz Arena rafters.

## QUICK HISTORY LESSON

► The Billikens won the 1948 National Invitation Tournament. That team was led by **Ed Macauley**, who went on to an NBA Hall of Fame career. Easy Ed's No. 50 is retired by SLU.  
 ► The AP poll was first released the next season, and SLU was the first-ever No. 1 in the inaugural poll on January 17, 1949.  
 ► **Anthony Bonner** (1986-90) is the Billikens' school-record holder in points (1,972) and rebounds (1,424).  
 ► SLU owns two regular-season A-10 titles (2013 and 2014), and it won the A-10 Tournament in 2013 and 2019 at Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y.  
 ► The Billikens have made 10 NCAA Tournament appearances, the last coming in 2019. SLU made three straight NCAA Tournaments from 2012-14, winning its opening game in all three.

## TRAVIS FORD

### Head Coach

Kentucky, 1994

Record at SLU: 140-94 (8th year)

Overall Record: 476-360 (27th year)

Travis Ford is in his eighth season at the helm of the Billiken basketball program and his 27th season as a collegiate head coach.

Hired in March 2016, Ford inherited a program that won 11 games in each of the two years prior. He proceeded to improve the Billikens' win total over the next four seasons.

Ford's tenure at SLU has been highlighted by three postseason appearances. Saint Louis captured the 2019 Atlantic 10 Conference Championship in dramatic fashion in Brooklyn and went to the NCAA Tournament. In a 2020-21 season that was derailed by COVID-19, the Billikens still managed to be in the conversation on Selection Sunday and ultimately was awarded a No. 1 seed in the NIT. The Billikens again went to the NIT in 2021-22. SLU was positioned for another postseason bid in 2019-20, but the season was canceled in March as SLU was preparing for the A-10 Championship.

The 2022-23 season is Ford's eighth year at SLU and his 27th season overall as a head coach. Ford is the third-winningest head coach in SLU men's basketball history.

In addition to his six years at SLU, Ford has had head-coaching stints at Oklahoma State (eight years, 2008-16), Massachusetts (three years, 2005-08), Eastern Kentucky (five years, 2000-05) and Campbellsville (1997-2000). Ford has led his team to the NCAA Tournament seven times. He has coached six players who have gone on to play in the NBA and eight who have been named a conference player of the year.

Ford came to SLU after eight seasons as head coach at Oklahoma State University, where he led the Cowboys to a 155-111 record and five NCAA Tournament appearances. He recruited three McDonald's All-Americans to Stillwater during his tenure.

Ford played the majority of his collegiate career at the University of Kentucky, helping the Wildcats to NCAA Tournament appearances in each of his three seasons (1992, 1993, 1994). He was a junior on the 1993 Wildcat team that advanced to the NCAA Final Four. Ford transferred to Kentucky after one season (1989-90) at the University of Missouri.
