
have considered the same and recommend that the attached House Bill No. _____, entitled:

House Bill No. **7869**

Introduced by Reps. Roger G. Mercado and Karlo Alexei B. Nograles

AN ACT
ESTABLISHING A FISH PORT IN BARANGAY ICHON, MUNICIPALITY OF
MACROHON, PROVINCE OF SOUTHERN LEYTE, AND APPROPRIATING
FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

Section 1. There shall be established, under the supervision of the Department of Agriculture, through the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) a fish port in Barangay Ichon, Municipality of Macrohon, Province of Southern Leyte.

Sec. 2. The PFDA shall, within two (2) years after the construction of the fish port, transfer the management of the same to the local government of the Municipality of Macrohon through a memorandum of agreement. The PFDA shall implement a training and phasing-in program for the local government personnel on the management and operation of the fish port.

Sec. 3. The Secretary of Agriculture shall include in the Department's program the construction of the fish port, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act. The local government of Macrohon shall set aside funds from any available local revenue in an amount deemed appropriate for its operationalization.

Sec. 4. Within sixty (60) days from the passage of this Act, the Secretary of Agriculture shall issue the rules and regulations on the supervision, monitoring, and the transfer of the management of the fish port to the local government of Macrohon.

Sec. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in any newspaper of general circulation.
