The California Collegiate Athletic Association has been the nation's most successful intercollegiate athletic conference since its establishment in December 1938.

The 13-member league is home to some of the nation's finest NCAA Division II athletic programs in Cal Poly Pomona, Cal State Dominguez Hills, Cal State East Bay, Cal State L.A., Cal State Monterey Bay, Cal State San Bernardino, Cal State San Marcos, Chico State, Humboldt State, San Francisco State, Sonoma State, Stanislaus State and UC San Diego.

CCAA institutions compete in seven women's and six men's conference-sponsored sports. Fall sports include men's and women's cross country, men's and women's soccer and women's volleyball. Men's and women's basketball are contested in the winter, and baseball, men's and women's golf, men's and women's outdoor track & field and softball comprise spring competition.

CCAA members have won 153 NCAA Championships (102 men, 51 women) all time, far and away the most of any Division II conference. On the men's side, CCAA members have brought home at least 10 titles in swimming & diving (25), wrestling (16), track & field (13), tennis (11) and baseball (10).

CCAA institutions have been very successful in the history of NCAA women's athletics, having won 10 cross country, 10 softball, six track & field, five volleyball and five basketball national championships as well as 16 more in four other sports.

The CCAA has undergone several changes in conference membership since charter members UC Santa Barbara, Fresno State, San Diego State and San Jose State came together to form the league in 1938. Over the past 73 years, a number of institutions have been members of the CCAA, including Cal State Bakersfield, Cal State Fullerton, Cal State Northridge, Cal Poly San Luis Obispo, Chapman, Grand Canyon University, Long Beach State, Pacific, Pepperdine, UC Davis, UC Riverside.

The CCAA Commissioner's Office is located in the San Francisco Bay Area-suburb of San Ramon.

River Oaks Golf Course & Event Center was established in 1979 by Jim and Carol Phipps and is now owned by the Hall and Thornberry families, both of Ceres. Since its inception, the course has been a staple for great golf in the Central Valley, and the new ownership group is poised to re-establish it as the premier public golf facility in Stanislaus County and one of the most well-conditioned and most enjoyable places to play golf in the Central Valley.

Its picturesque location lays along the banks of the beautiful Tuolumne River in Ceres, Calif. The first nine sits atop the river bluff and totals 1,111 yards. The second nine sits below the river bluff along the Tuolumne River.

Looking forward, the Hall and Thornberry families have plans to have a first class golf facility, a place for beautiful weddings, and an event center to cater to weddings, parties, and corporate outings. The River Oaks property is truly unique and attracts patrons from hours away to enjoy its golf course and scenic views.

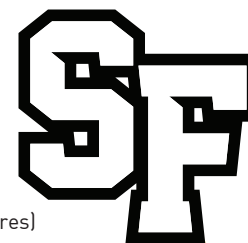

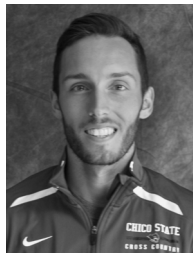

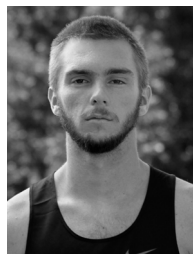
