NOTABLES

- Saint Louis begins the month of December with a rivalry game as it heads to Carbondale to face the Southern Illinois Salukis.
- It's the start of a rare non-conference road swing for the Bills, as they travel next to Des Moines to face Drake on Wednesday, Dec.
 This is the first time since the 2013-14 season that SLU will be playing consecutive road games during the non-conference slate.
- Gibson Jimerson has posted season-high scoring totals in each of the last two games, scoring 28 points against Utah State after tallying 23 against Dartmouth. For the year, he scores 15.6 ppg.
- **Terrence Hargrove Jr.** is third on the team in scoring (15.5 ppg) and tops in rebounding (5.9 rpg). He has scored in double figures in four straight.
- Michael Meadows Jr. leads the Atlantic 10 and ranks 14th nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio (4.67). Cian Medley has 10 assists to just one turnover in the last three games combined.
- **Kellen Thames** has recorded at least one steal in every game and ranks third in the A-10 with 13 on the year.
- Leading scorer Sincere Parker (17.3 ppg) is out 4-6 weeks after suffering a foot injury against Wyoming on Nov. 16.
- As a team, the Billikens lead the A-10 in free-throws made per game (18.1), 3-point field goal percentage (.386) and fastbreak points (14.6 per game).
- Both Saint Louis and Southern Illinois benefit from the charity stripe as both lead their league in FTs made per game.

WHAT'S ON TAP?

- ► Saint Louis (5-3) opens a two-game road swing on Saturday afternoon when it heads to Carbondale to face the Southern Illinois Salukis at Banterra Center. Game time is 2:30 p.m.
- ► Then, the Billikens travel north to face another Missouri Valley Conference squad in Drake on Wednesday, Dec. 6. Game time at the Knapp Center in Des Moines is 7 p.m.

FOLLOWING THE ACTION

- ► Saturday's game against Southern Illinois will not be televised. It will be streamed live on ESPN+.
- ► KMOX 1120 AM serves as the Home for Billiken Basketball on the radio. Billiken Hall of Famers and longtime SLU men's basketball radio partners **Bob Ramsey** and **Earl Austin Jr.** will the call the action for all SLU games, both at home and on the road.

LAST TIME OUT

- ► Saint Louis trimmed a 20-point deficit to three with 18 seconds to play in the second half, but Utah State held on for an 81-76 win over the Billikens Tuesday night at Chaifetz Arena.
- ► **Gibson Jimerson** scored a game- and season-high 28 points and matched his season high of five assists for SLU, which slipped to 5-3. Utah State of the Mountain West Conference improved to 6-1.
- ► Michael Meadows Jr. and Terrence Hargrove Jr. tallied 11 points apiece in the second half and finished with 18 and 14 points, respectively. Meadows added four assists.
- ► The Billikens equaled their season high of 10 3-pointers, shooting 41.7 percent (10-of-24) from the arc. SLU's 92.3 percent (12-of-13) performance from the foul line was its season best.
- ► SLU utilized 10-0 and 11-0 runs in the second half to not go down quietly against the Aggies and pull to within a possession of the lead late. However, the Aggies sank two free throws with 10 seconds to play, and the Billikens could not answer.

CHALLENGING SCHEDULE

- ► The Billikens are in the midst of a challenging portion in their schedule, with six opponents having a KenPom rating at 140 or better (through games of Nov. 29).
- ► Utah State has the best KenPom rating of an opponent that SLU has played this season at No. 67.
- ▶ Dayton (61) and Duquesne (79) are the top A-10 teams in KenPom's ratings.

ABOUT SOUTHERN ILLINOIS

- ► Southern Illinois enters Saturday's game with a 4-2 overall record. The Salukis have already started Missouri Valley Conference play and are coming off a 77-48 loss in their MVC opener Tuesday at Indiana State.
- ► **Xavier Johnson** leads Southern Illinois with 21.8 ppg. He also dished out a team-best 28 assists and leads the Salukis with eight steals.
- ► **Jovan Stulic** has come off the bench to average 9.2 ppg, second on the squad. **Clarence Rupert** is the Salukis' top rebounder at 7.3 rpg.
- ▶ Trent Brown is SIU's top 3-point shooter in both makes (15) and percentage (.536).
- ► Last season, Southern Illinois went 23-10 and 14-6 in MVC play. The Salukis fell to Drake in the semifinals of the MVC Tournament.
- ► Head coach **Bryan Mullins** is in his fifth season at his alma mater with a 71-57 record.

SERIES HISTORY

- ► Saint Louis leads the all-time series against the Salukis 33-27.
- ► This will be the 61st meeting between the Billikens and Salukis, tying SIU for eighth among SLU's most common opponents.
- Southern Illinois leads 17-8 in games played in Carbondale, including a two-game win streak on its home court. The last time the Billikens won at the Banterra Center was Nov. 16, 2013, a 76-67 triumph.
- ► Southern Illinois is the Billikens' most common non-conference opponent. The Bills and Salukis were never in the Missouri Valley Conference at the same time despite both programs' long history in the league. SIU joined the MVC in 1975-76, two years after Saint Louis left the MVC to eventually join the Metro Conference.

ROAD-TRIPPING

- ▶The Billikens are embarking on a rare two-game nonconference road trip, as SLU heads to Drake next on Wednesday, Dec. 6.
- ▶It's the first time in the **Travis Ford** era and the first time since 2013-14 that the Billikens are playing back-toback non-conference games on the road. (at SIUE Nov. 13, 2013; at Southern Illinois Nov. 16, 2013).
- ► Saint Louis is 4-10 in non-conference road games under Ford. The Billikens' last non-conference road win was an 86-82 overtime triumph at Boise State. Other non-con road wins under Ford was at Boston College (2019-20), at Kansas State (2019-20) and at Seton Hall (2018-19).

TRACKING JIMERSON

- ▶ **Gibson Jimerson** has led the Billikens in scoring in each of the last two games, posting season highs in each.
- ►SLU's leading scorer each of the last two seasons, he is working his way up several categories in the SLU record book. He is third in school history with 250 3-pointers made, third in career FT percentage (.848), fifth in career 3FG percentage (.406) and 13th in career points (1,428).
- ► Among all active NCAA Division players, Jimerson is 68th in career points, 38th in career 3FG% and 32nd in career 3s made.
- ▶ Jimerson's 1,428 career points is 13th in SLU history. He surpassed Billiken great Ed Macauley in the game against Utah
- ► Last season, Jimerson led the Billikens with 14.0 ppg and was second in the A-10 in 3FG percentage (85-212, .401) and third in the league in 3-pointers made per game (2.58).
- ▶ Jimerson announced on March 29 his intention to return to the Billikens. In fact, while this is Jimerson's fifth season with the Billikens, he is technically a junior eligibility wise. He received a medical hardship waiver his first season (2019-20) after injuring his foot after playing in 10 games, the maximum amount of games allowed for him to play in and still receive the waiver. The 2020-21 season did not count against a players' eligibility due to
- ▶ Dec. 17, 2022, was a special day for Jimerson. In the morning, he walked across the stage at Chaifetz Arena in a cap and gown during SLU's Midyear Commencements and received a B.S. in International Business. Later that night in a game against Drake in the same Chaifetz Arena, he registered his 1,000th career point. Jimerson was named an Academic All-American in 2021-22.

HARGROVE AMONG SLU'S TOP SCORERS

- ▶ Terrence Hargrove Jr. is averaging 15.5 ppg, just shy of Jimerson's 15.6 ppg mark. (Sincere Parker is at 17.3 ppg but is out with a foot injury).
- ► Hargrove is averaging 16.8 ppg over his last four games. He averaged 15 points and 5.7 rebounds in the Myrtle Beach Invitational en route to All-Tournament team honors.
- ▶ Back for his fifth season with the Bills, Hargrove has played in 120 games in his career and could surpass the school record for games played this year. That record is currently held by **Dwayne Evans** and **Jordair Jett**, who played in 134 games from 2010-14.
- ▶ Last year, Hargrove appeared in all 33 games and made 16 starts. He was third on the Billikens with 20 blocked shots. In A-10 play, Hargrove shot better than 50 percent and averaged 7.7 points and 4.2 rebounds.
- ► Hargrove was the recipient of the U.S. Basketball Writers Association 2023 Perry Wallace Most Courageous Award for coming forward to discuss his mental health and helping to remove any stigma still associated with that, and to also acknowledge the many issues college basketball players - and athletes in all sports - have faced before, during and after the pandemic.

PARKER OUT 4-6 WEEKS WITH FOOT INJURY

- ▶ Junior **Sincere Parker** suffered a fracture in his right foot Nov. 16 against Wyoming and is out 4-6 weeks.
- ► He had a career-best 22 points against the Cowboys and was leading the Billikens with eight boards before leaving with eight minutes left in the second half with the injury.

- ▶ Parker's 17.3 ppg this season leads the Billikens.
- ▶ Last season, Parker played in all 33 games and averaged 5.9 points and 3.7 rebounds. He shot 42.3 percent from the field and was third on the team with 23 3-pointers made.

DALGER INTO STARTING ROLE

- Senior **Tim Dalger** came off the bench in the Billikens' first three games, but was inserted into the starting lineup against Wyoming in the Myrtle Beach Invitational and has been starting ever since.
- ▶ He was especially productive in the win against Wyoming, scoring 17 points and registering three steals.
- ► For the season, Dalger scores 9.5 ppg and hauls in 5.1 rpg.

THAMES CONTRIBUTING IN PARKER'S ABSENCE

- ▶One of the players who figures to see more playing time for the injured Sincere Parker is sophomore **Kellen Thames**.
- ► Thames did not disappoint after playing the most substantial minutes of his career in the three games at the Myrtle Beach Invitational. He averaged 7.0 ppg and 4.7 rpg in the three games.
- ▶Thames has at least one steal in all eight games this season and leads the Billikens with 13. That total ranks third in the conference.

POINT GUARDS PROTECTING THE BALL

- ▶ Point guards **Michael Meadows Jr.** and **Cian Medley have** combined to dish out 48 assists to 15 turnovers this year.
- ► For the season, Meadows has an A-10 leading 4.67 assist-to-turnover ratio, 14th in the NCAA.
- ▶In the last three games, Medley has 10 assists to just one turnover.
- ▶ This is the first time in four years that **Yuri Collins** isn't manning the point guard spot at SLU as he has graduated and moved on to his professional career.
- ► Collins holds every assists record in SLU school history, and is the A-10 career assists leader as well.
- ► In his four-year Billiken career, he totaled 878 assists and finished with 1,002 career points. He is 22nd in NCAA history in career assists and ranks 16th in NCAA history in assists average.

HUGHES II ON SCHOLARSHIP, IN STARTING LINEUP

- ▶ Larry Hughes II was technically a preferred walk-on last season and is on scholarship this season. He drilled three treys en route to 12 points in the opener against Southern Indiana. He has started every game this season and is averaging 5.9 ppg.
- ► He appeared in 27 games last year and made his first-career start in the win at George Washington for an ailing **Yuri Collins**. Hughes played a career-high 26 minutes in that game at GW.
- ► Hughes had a then career-high 12 points against VCU in the A-10 semifinals, going 3-of-5 from the field, 3-of-4 from downtown and 3-of-3 from the line.

BRUUUUUUUCE ZHANG DEBUTS

- Seven-foot freshman center **Bruce Zhang** made his collegiate debut Nov. 11 against Illinois State. He converted a 3-point play for this first-collegiate points to bring the Chaifetz Arena crowd to its feet.
- ▶Zhang matched his career high with five points against Wichita State. He has hit all six of his FTs this year.
- ▶ Billikens fans are quick to yell "Bruuuuuuce" each time Zhang checks in or scores. It's familiar territory for St. Louis sports fans as they would do the same each time Super Bowl XXXIV champion and NFL Hall of Famer **Isaac Bruce** would catch a pass for St. Louis Rams from 1995-2007.

BASKETBALL BLOODLINES

- ▶ Larry Hughes II is the son of Billiken great Larry Hughes. Larry Hughes played one season at SLU in 1997-98 before enjoying a long and successful career in the NBA. In his lone season with the Bills, Larry Hughes scored a school record 670 points and led the Bills to an NCAA Tournament appearance. Additionally, Larry Hughes Jr.'s sister, Lauryn, graduated from SLU in 2021 after playing four seasons on the SLU women's basketball team.
- ► **Kellen Thames** is the son of **Kelly Thames**, who from 1993-98 started at the University of Missouri and scored more than 1,600 points for the Tigers.

GLOBAL BILLIKENS

- ► Saint Louis went international in its recruiting as the Billikens added four freshmen from overseas.
- ▶ **Djordje Curcic**, a 6-2 guard, hails from Serbia. He was one of the youngest players in the ABA League and was part of Serbia's youth national team setup including the 2023 FIBA U19 Basketball World Cup in Hungary

- ▶ **Abou Magassa**, a 6-7 forward, is a native of France. He averaged 11 points and five rebounds for Chorale Roanne Basket in Roanne, France.
- ► **Stef van Bussel**, a 6-10 center, is from the Netherlands. He is returning to full strength after missing the majority of the offseason with an injury. He played at a high-level in Germany during his youth.
- ▶ **Bruce Zhang** is a 7-0 center from China who comes to SLU via The Skill Factory in Atlanta. His first name is Chenzhifeng, but was given his American name by his high school English teacher.

HOME SWEET CHAIFETZ

- Saint Louis is in its 16th season playing inside the 10,600-seat Chaifetz
- ► SLU is 200-69 all-time at Chaifetz Arena, including 4-1 this year.
- ► Chaifetz Arena is named after SLU alumnus **Dr. Richard A. Chaifetz**. Dr. Chaifetz is a world-renowned entrepreneur and business leader, who in 1984 founded ComPsych Corporation, which today is the world's largest provider of employee assistance programs, behavioral health and wellness services.

JIMERSON UP FOR ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICAN

▶ **Gibson Jimerson**, who graduated with a degree in international business with a GPA above 3.9, was named and Academic All-American in 2021-22 and will be up for the award this year as well. It has been a stated goal by Jimerson to earn the prestigious honor this season.

▶ Other Academic All-Americans in school history are **Rich Niemann** (1968), **Ted Mimlitz** (1986), **Scott Highmark** (1994 & 1995), **Kevin Lisch** (2009) and **Brian Conklin** (2012).

REMEMBERING FORD STUEN

- ▶ The Billikens remember and honor assistant coach **Ford Stuen**, who passed away May 11, 2021, at the age of 29. Stuen, the nephew of head coach **Travis Ford**, played at Oklahoma State for his uncle and served on the Billikens' staff for five years.
- ► SLU players wear a patch on their jersey with the "FS" script. That is how Stuen would sign his name on the many hand-written notes and letters that he would send to family, friends, and coaching colleagues.



▶ On opening night, Nov. 9, 2021, a banner was unveiled honoring **Ford Stuen** that will forever hang in the Chaifetz Arena rafters.

QUICK HISTORY LESSON

- ▶ The Billikens won the 1948 National Invitation Tournament. That team was led by **Ed Macauley**, who went on to an NBA Hall of Fame career. Easy Ed's No. 50 is retired by SLU.
- ► The AP poll was first released the next season, and SLU was the first-ever No. 1 in the inaugural poll on January 17, 1949.
- ► **Anthony Bonner** (1986-90) is the Billikens' school-record holder in points (1,972) and rebounds (1,424).
- ► SLU owns two regular-season A-10 titles (2013 and 2014), and it won the A-10 Tournament in 2013 and 2019 at Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y.
- ► The Billikens have made 10 NCAA Tournament appearances, the last coming in 2019. SLU made three straight NCAA Tournaments from 2012-14, winning its opening game in all three.

TRAVIS FORD

Head Coach Kentucky, 1994 Record at SLU: 138-92 (8th year) Overall Record: 474-358 (27th year)

Travis Ford is in his eighth season at the helm of the Billiken basketball program and his 27th season as a collegiate head coach

Hired in March 2016, Ford inherited a program that won 11 games in each of the two years prior. He proceeded to improve the Billikens' win total over the next four seasons.

Ford's tenure at SLU has been highlighted by three postseason appearances. Saint Louis captured the 2019 Atlantic 10 Conference Championship in dramatic fashion in Brooklyn and went to the NCAA Tournament. In a 2020-21 season that was derailed by COVID-19, the Billikens still managed to be in the conversation on Selection Sunday and ultimately was awarded a No. 1 seed in the NIT. The Billikens again went to the NIT in 2021-22. SLU was positioned for another postseason bid in 2019-20, but the season was canceled in March as SLU was preparing for the A-10 Championship.

The 2022-23 season is Ford's eighth year at SLU and his 27th season overall as a head coach. Ford is the third-winningest head coach in SLU men's basketball history.

In addition to his six years at SLU, Ford has had head-coaching stints at Oklahoma State (eight years, 2008-16), Massachusetts (three years, 2005-08), Eastern Kentucky (five years, 2000-05) and Campbellsville (1997-2000). Ford has led his team to the NCAA Tournament seven times. He has coached six players who have gone on to play in the NBA and eight who have been named a conference player of the year.

Ford came to SLU after eight seasons as head coach at Oklahoma State University, where he led the Cowboys to a 155-111 record and five NCAA Tournament appearances. He recruited three McDonald's All-Americans to Stillwater during his tenure.

Ford played the majority of his collegiate career at the University of Kentucky, helping the Wildcats to NCAA Tournament appearances in each of his three seasons (1992, 1993, 1994). He was a junior on the 1993 Wildcat team that advanced to the NCAA Final Four. Ford transferred to Kentucky after one season (1989-90) at the University of Missouri.

Ford, is a native of Madisonville, Kentucky. He and his wife, Heather, have three children: Brooks, Kyleigh and Shane. Ford earned a bachelor's degree in communications at the University of Kentucky in 1994.






