NSS Camp First Day - 23 February 2023

The first day of the Winter Special Camp was inaugurated by Teachers in Charge, Prof. Sanjib Kumar Mukherjee, Garhbeta College. He inaugurated the NSS Winter Special Camp – 2023 with NSS Advisory Committee by lighting the lamp and addressed the NSS Volunteers about importance of NSS in conserving Cultural heritage, social harmony, and also development for way of life in rural areas.

Prof. Susanta Kr Mandal, Programme Officer, NSS Unit IV of the college welcomed the guests and talked about the proposed activities of the camp. Prof (Dr.) Santimoy Patra & Prof. Soma Samanta, Member of NSS Advisory Committee, Garhbeta College, addressed all the NSS volunteers as to the importance of the camp and wished a successful completion of the camp. At the end, a cultural programme was also organised by NSS volunteers and students of the college.

Second Day – 24th February 2023

The 2nd day, 24 February 2023 of this special camp was started by the physical exercise of 60 volunteers of 4 units (15 volunteers from each unit) from 7 am to 9 am and this activity was followed daily throughout the Special Camp. It was followed by breakfast at 9 am. Later on, all the areas of college campus were cleaned by these campers. After lunch at the middle phase, there was organised an engrossing lecture on 'Preliminary health issues for all' by the respected speaker Dr. Sanchita Karmkar, BMOH of Garhbeta Block Hospital. She has given some important tips for primary health care of our life. Then there was an arrangement of games & sports for all the NSS campers and at the last phase of the day, the cultural programme was organised for developing the mental growth of students in the Seminar Hall from 4 pm to 5 pm.

Third Day–25th February 2023

The 3rd day of this trip was started with Yoga & Meditation by all the campers and then there was visited to the adopted village of unit I at Mairakata Tantipara by the volunteers of 4 NSS units. Firstly, the volunteers meet primary school to learn about environment of education in the school and they interacted with the children of the school. The volunteers also interviewed the people present there and gathered information about the problems faced for every day of life. And after lunch on that day, there was organised an important lecture on "Consumer Rights Awareness Programme" by the Honourable speakers – Puloke Roy and Santanu Kumar Das, Officers of Department of Consumer Affairs, Regional Zone, Paschim Medinipur. And then, games and sports for the campers and at last the cultural programme in the Seminar Hall on various aspects was organised.

Fourth Day – 26th February 2023

Like the 2nd day and the 4th day physical exercise was also started on 26 February from 7 am to 9 am and then there was a visit to adopt village of Unit II for the survey purposes by 4 units to Gangani Badam Colony. NSS Volunteers went for home visit and conducted survey on various health issues for the villagers and they also analysed their surveys. These helped the volunteers to have a good communication with the villagers. After lunch, a special deliberation was performed by Prof. Susanta kr. Mandal, Prof. Mousumi Pal and other NSS Programme Officers, Garhbeta College. Then the games & sports and at last cultural competition were held by all the campers.

Fifth Day – 27th February 2023

Like previous days the fifth day also was begun with Yoga and Meditation and thereafter there was a visit to the adopted village of Unit III by all the units' campers to Ghotboni, Garhbeta. The NSS Volunteers went for home visit and conducted survey on various health issues for the villagers and they also analysed their surveys. These helped the volunteers to have a good communication with the villagers.

Next in the Seminar Hall, an amazing lecture on "Proper Nutrition & Sound Health" by the eminent speaker Dr. Debidas Ghosh, Professor & HOD, Department of Bio-Medical Laboratory Science & Management of Vidyasagar University. All the participants of the camp, learned how to maintain proper diet based on daily routine of healthy food and nutrition. In the same way, the game & sports were arranged for the campers and at last, the interesting cultural programme was organised by the students.

Sixth Day – 28th February 2023

The 6th day of the Winter Special Camp was started with physical exercise and then a visit was conducted adopted village Lapuria and then an attractive lecture on "Observation of National Science Day" by the honourable speaker Dr. Prabir Ranjan Sur, the Former Scientist of the Department of Botanical Survey of India, Kolkata was organised. After the precious lecture, campers organised a cultural programme.

Seventh Day – 01st March 2023

The last day of this memorable camp was begun with Yoga and Meditation and was surveyed to their respective adopted villages and the work of campus cleaning was also done The function was very successful along with the performance of the volunteers. At last in the Valedictory session, the Vote of thanks for the function was given by NSS Volunteers. Thus the NSS winter special camp was conducted successfully.
