

Ledbetter, Kentucky Section 14*Project site in the City of Ledbetter, KY***Current Phase:**

Feasibility

Location and Description:

The project is located within the corporate city limits of Ledbetter in Livingston County, Kentucky along Riverside Drive. The project is located within the 1st Congressional District of Kentucky.

The project will examine measures of bank stabilization for slope failures along approximately 160 feet of shoreline on the Ohio River near Riverside Drive. The principal cause of the erosion is the scouring of the bank due to the high velocities that concentrate along the left bank of the river during high flow conditions. The project will also evaluate bank stabilization directly upstream and downstream of the project that may be considered as betterments at the expense of the Non-Federal Sponsor.
