


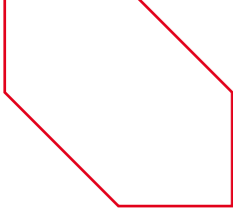

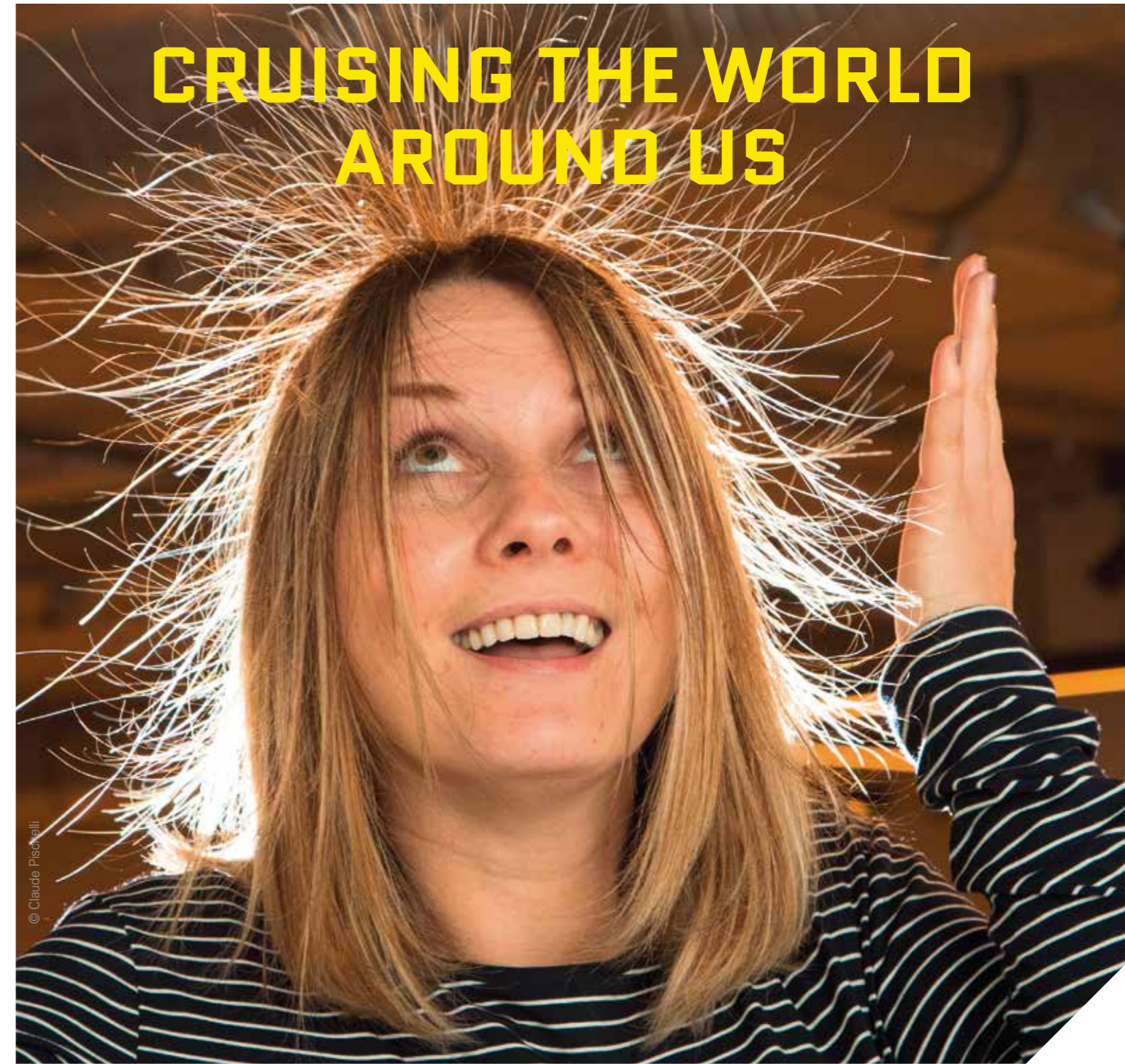
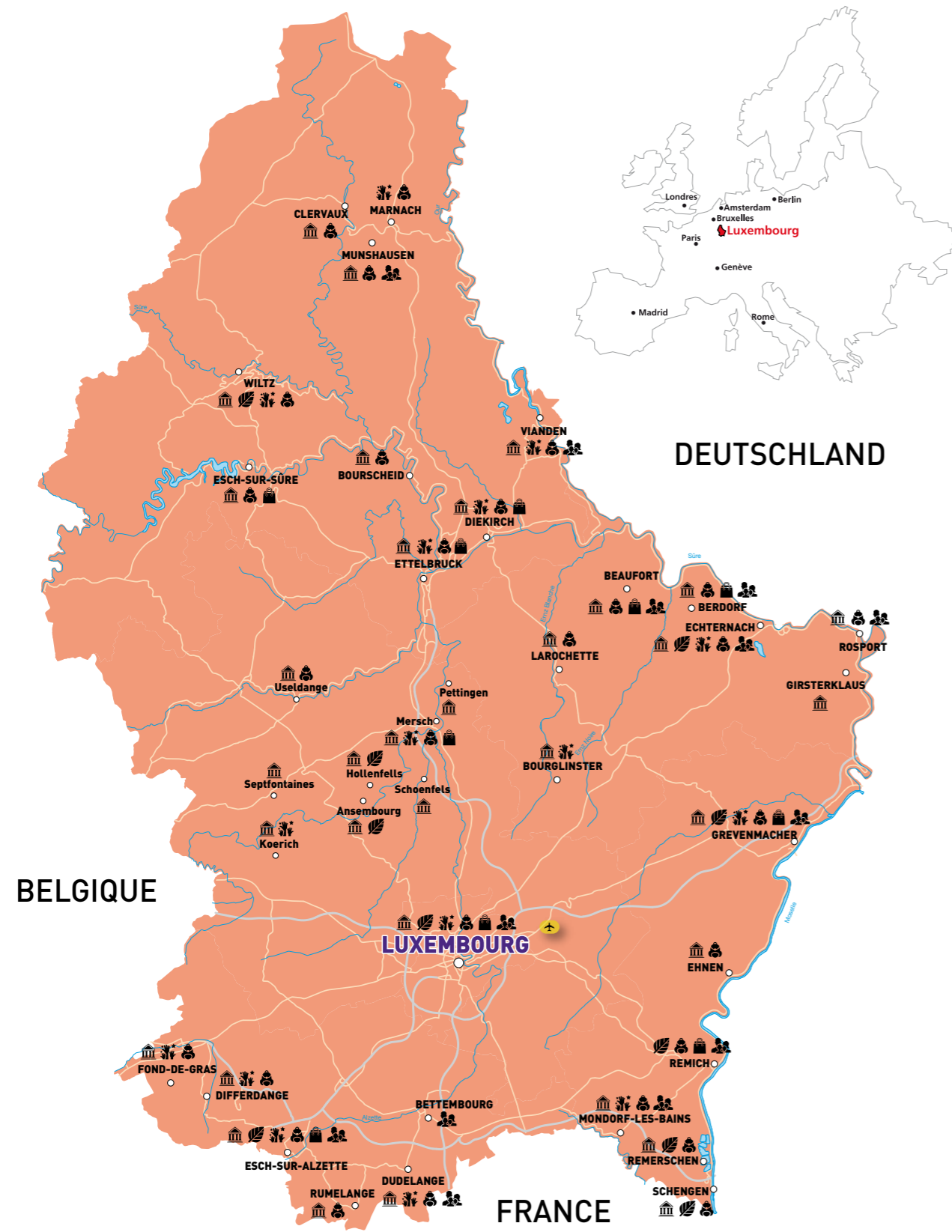

Vianden Castle. Open daily except on 1.1, 2.11 and 25.12. In January, February, November and December from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. In March and October from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. From April to September from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Guided visits on request.

An extraordinary network of underground galleries, the famous casemates, which were carved from the city's rocks constitute the city's main attraction. Recognized by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site. Bock casemates (fortifications from the 18th century). Open from 15.2 to 3.11 daily from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The Dancing Procession on Whit Tuesday attracts thousands of pilgrims (recognized on the UNESCO Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity).

The exhibition "The Family of Man" consists of 503 photographs taken by 273 photographers from 68 different countries. It was recorded in the UNESCO Memory of the World Program in 2003 and has been described as the greatest photographic project ever undertaken. Open from 1.3 till 1.1 from Wednesday to Sunday from 12 a.m. to 6 p.m. Closed on Tuesday.

Museum of Modern Art Grand-Duc Jean - MUDAM. The location of this museum is worth being noted. The Sino-American architect Ieoh Ming Pei converted the former Thüngen fortress (1732) into a strategic place of artistic creation. Open from Wednesday to Friday from 11 a.m. to 8 p.m., from Saturday to Monday from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. Closed on Tuesday.

Amid plains and woods, strewn with lakes and rivers, Luxembourg's landscapes are enchanting as well as fascinating. Nature in Luxembourg also means to unexpectedly discover a picturesque village, a mysterious ruin or a simply breathtaking landscape behind every curve. Rock formations, meandering streams or colourful flora - nature in Luxembourg still knows some spots untouched by mankind. Between family tours, hiking or romantic excursions, Luxembourg has plenty of natural space waiting to be discovered, the whole year through.

The Nature Park Our is located in the north-east of the Luxembourg Ardennes. In the House of the Nature Park Our, an exhibition presents the numerous facets of the region. Opening hours : Every day from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Free admission. Guided tours on request.

The Nature Park of the Upper Sûre was the first nature park of Luxembourg. The Nature Park Centre Upper Sûre includes an information center, a permanent exhibition on the nature park, a shop with local products and a museum. Open daily (except Wednesdays) from 10 to 12 a.m. and from 2 to 6 p.m., on Saturday, Sunday and public holidays from 2 to 6 p.m. In winter until 5 p.m. Guided tours on request.

The nature conservation centre of the nature reserve *Haff Réimech* is the entry point to nature and to the region. Permanent exhibition on the topics: bird migration, conservation measures, history of the nature reserve and much more. Every day except Monday: from 01.11. to 31.03.: 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., from 01.04. to 31.10.: from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Guided tour on request.

This former open-cast mining area "Prénzeberg - Giele Botter" is today a nature reserve. After the end of the mining exploitation, nature has taken over and the area and new habitats have developed.

Forest covers more than one-third of the nature park's 256km² surface area. The water runs clear and pure from local springs. Thanks to the park management, the water coming from many of these springs, is of the highest quality. Themed trails highlight animal and plant life, history, culture, local handicrafts, and architecture. Regional products are part of the region's character, and point to a sustainable local economy.



WHERE TO GO OUT IN LUXEMBOURG

Luxembourg boasts a wide variety of nightlife that suits diverse palates. Out of ideas for tonight? Let's make a few suggestions: the first course will consist of an exquisite meal in one of Luxembourg's restaurants; as a main course, our agenda would like to suggest a varied offer of concerts, theatres and exposes; after a drink or two in one of Luxembourg's hopping bars, the dessert will be served up in full discotheque mode with a fantastic array of clubbing options on hand. 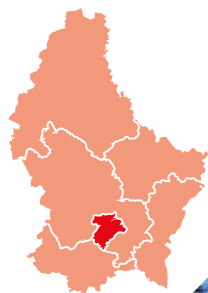

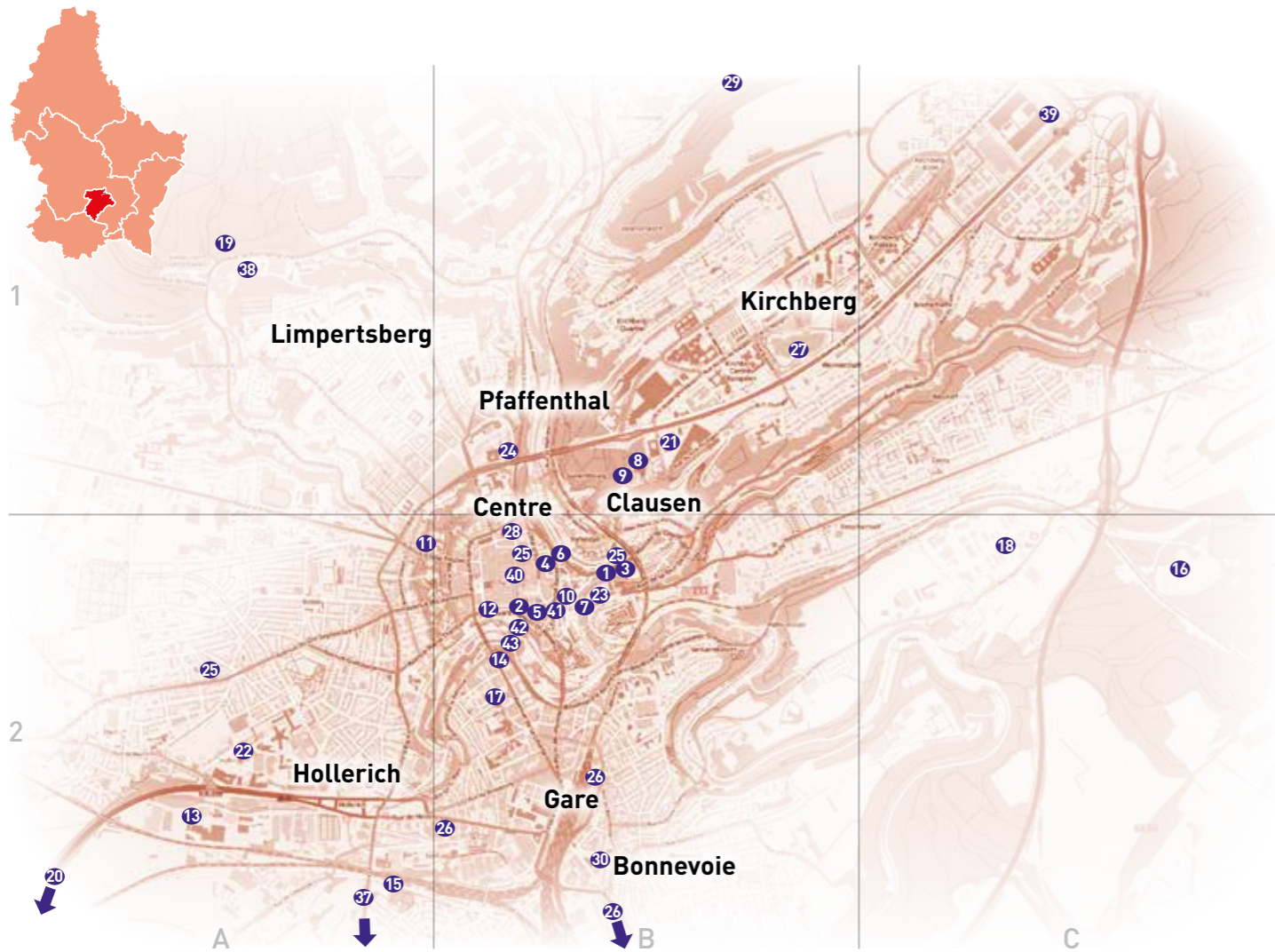

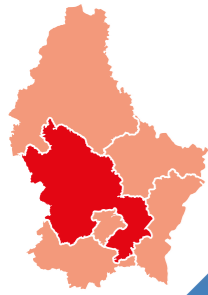

The surrounding region of the capital is blessed with an extraordinary historic heritage set in a well-preserved natural environment. Calm and off-the-beaten-track, it is still close to the Moselle River, the Mullerthal, the Red Rock region and the Ardennes. Close to the capital, this is the perfect place to relax, enjoy nature or go on a bike tour.

VALLEY OF THE SEVEN CASTLES

Starting in Mersch, a small town at the centre of the country, the valley of the seven castles will surprise you with its beauty and its varied feudal castles dating from medieval times. Also close to the valley is Useldange castle, which has the highest donjon in the country. It also features a trail for the partially sighted, an initiative which had been recognised by UNESCO. Churches and chapels of Romanesque sobriety, Gothic flamboyance, and baroque splendour dot the countryside.

A CYCLISTS PARADISE

Cycle trails crisscross the region, each with its own unique charm and points of interest. The trail by the Attert river follows the route of an old railway line, telling the story of a bygone industrial heritage. A path meanders along the Alzette valley, through fields and the small town of Walferdange and its rose gardens. To quench one's thirst after this effort, why not sample refreshing local products such as Beckerich water and milk at the Vitarium in Roost?

MEMORIES OF THE PAST

Lively, friendly festivals are held throughout the year at regional distilleries, the mill in Beckerich, around the pottery factory in Nospelt (Easter Monday), the castles in Ansembourg, Koerich, Pettingen and Useldange and in many other places. Second World War military cemeteries in Sandweiler and Hamm bear witness to Luxembourg's wartimes, with annual commemorative ceremonies underlining the values

of reconciliation and respect for the dead. In this regard, the park of Colpach Castle is worth a visit, as in the 1920s writers and thinkers such as André Gide, Annette Kolb, Jean Schlumberger, and Karl Jaspers chose this place to work on their ideas for sustainable world peace.

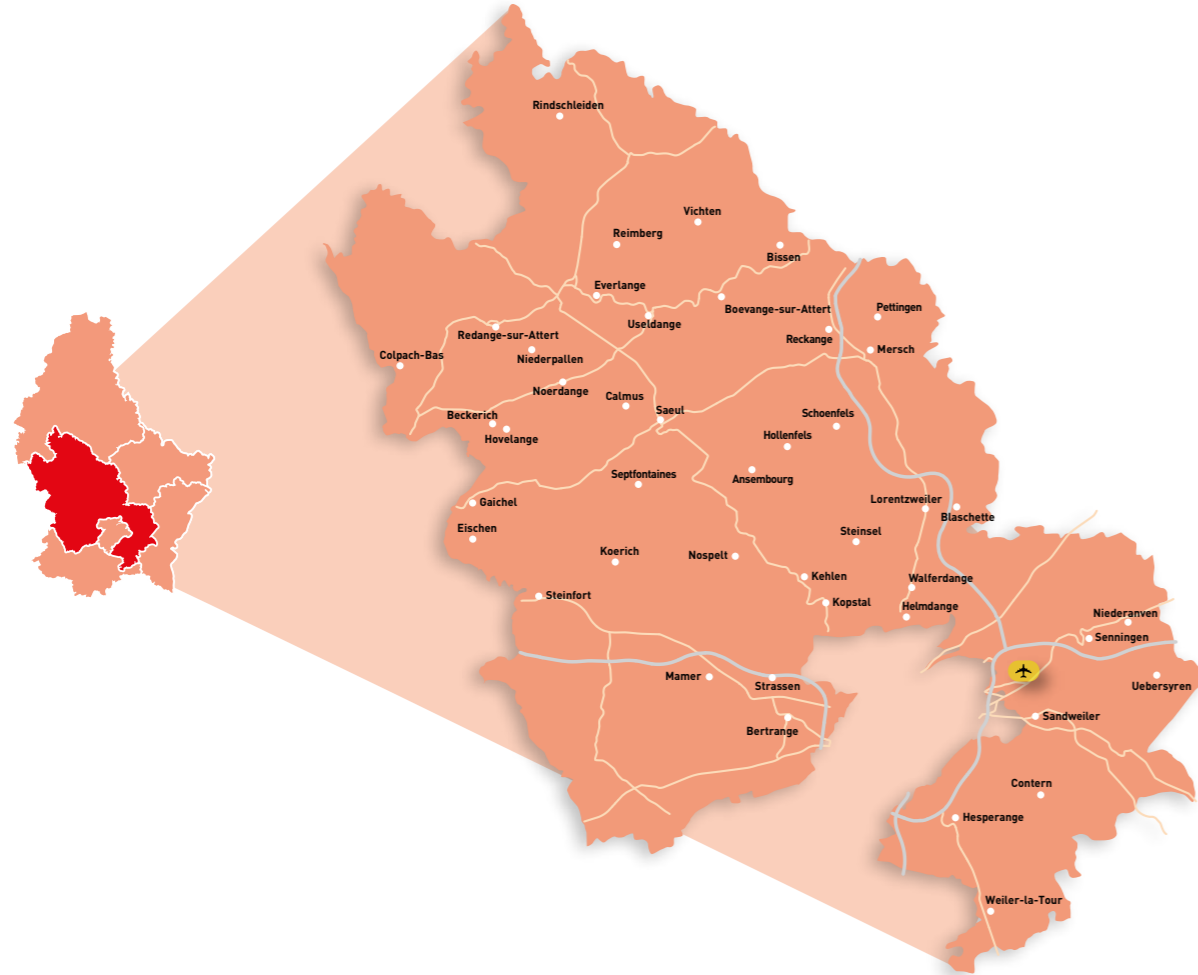

The castle valleys

So many different types of feudal architecture in such close proximity is exceptional: castles in Ansembourg (Hotel), Hollenfels, Schoenfels, Septfontaines, Pettingen, Mersch, Useldange with a didactic tour (also for visually impaired), a baroque residence in Ansembourg with a French garden and a mythological alley and a moated castle in Koerich. On the river banks the vegetation is in parts very wild, almost primeval. Often referred to as Luxembourg's Little Switzerland, the Mullerthal Region - or Mëllerdall in Luxembourgish - owes its name to its hilly landscape reminiscent of Switzerland. The region is above all a unique biotope characterized by rock formations that are as beguiling as they are surprising. It is the unique composition of the rock and soil erosion that have contributed to the creation of this landscape so typical of Luxembourg's Little Switzerland.

ECHTERNACH LUXEMBOURG'S OLDEST CITY

"Capital" of the Mullerthal Region, Echternach is the oldest town in Luxembourg. In 2010, the city and its old abbey acquired an international reputation by its inscription into the Intangible Heritage of UNESCO of the famous Dancing Procession. Among the major tourist attractions of the city are the Roman Villa, the Benedictine Abbey of Saint Willibrord and the cultural centre Trifolion.

HIKING THE MULLERTHAL TRAIL

The Mullerthal Trail takes the experienced hiker through 112 km of magnificent valley trails. Rock formations are dotted with difficult sounding names - Piteschkummer, Geierslee or Huel Lee, to name only a few. NATURPARK MËLLERDALL

Forests cover more than one-third of the nature park's 256km² surface area. Water runs clear and pure from local springs. Thanks to the park management, the water coming from many of these springs, is of the highest quality. Themed trails highlight fauna and flora, history, culture, local handicrafts and architecture. Regional products are part of the region's character and point to a sustainable local economy. Particular attention is devoted to the preservation of traditional buildings.

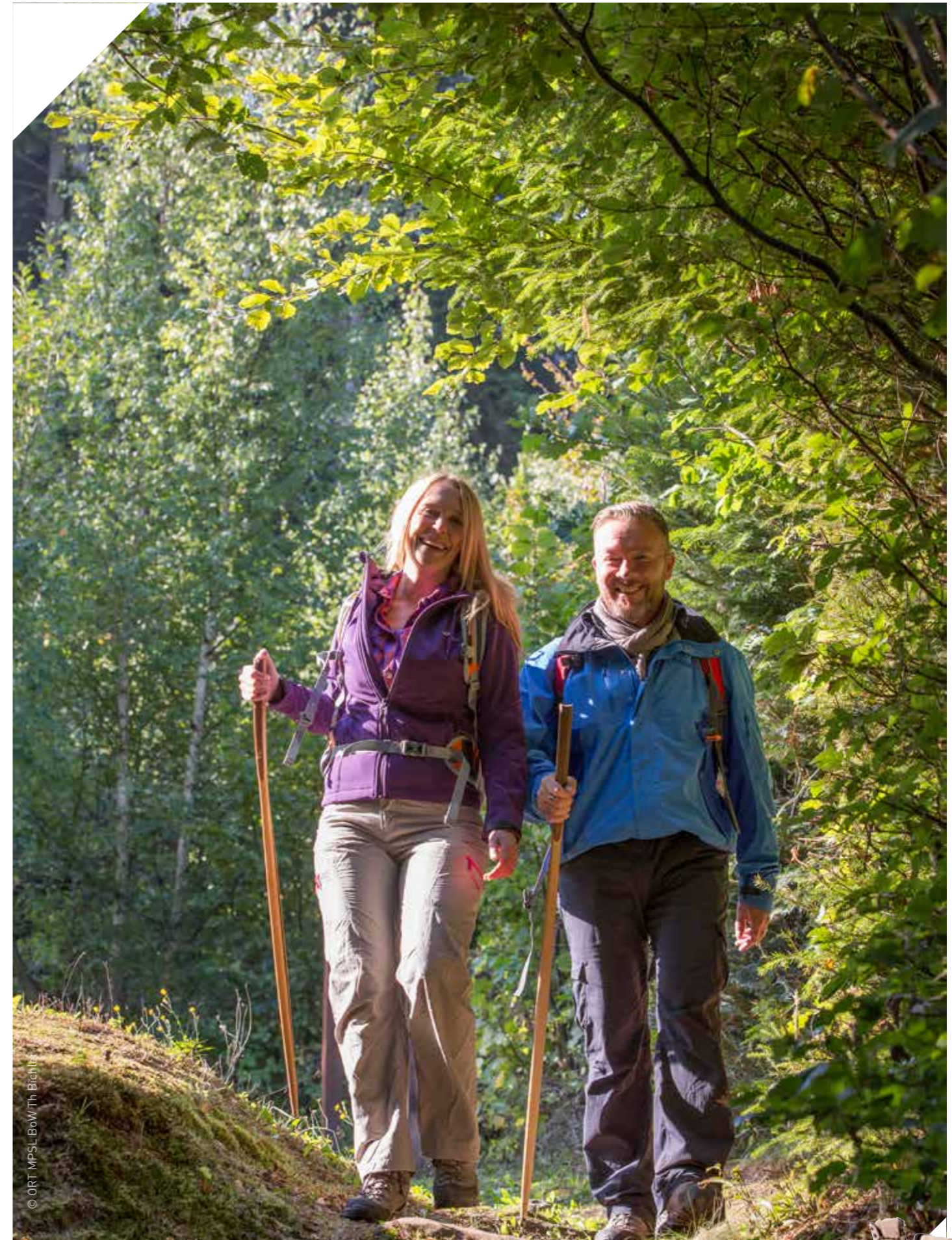

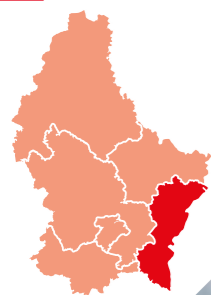

The Moselle River is the major river of Luxembourg. Its trajectory along the Luxembourg border runs 42 km in length to form a natural boundary with Germany. Moselle lends its name to one of the most beautiful valleys of Luxembourg, famous for its wineries, charming hotels and medieval towns. "D'Musel," as it is affectionately known by its inhabitants, is also a region of traditions such as the cavalcade of Remich and the Grape and Wine festival in Grevenmacher.

The valley of the Moselle in Luxembourg is famous for its steep hills and vineyards. It is the birthplace of Luxembourg wines, mostly white varieties such as Riesling, Auxerrois and Pinot Gris. The hinterland of the Moselle is home to large plantations of fruit trees for the production of fresh juices, liqueurs and schnapps. It was in the Luxembourg Moselle region, specifically in the wine village of Schengen, where

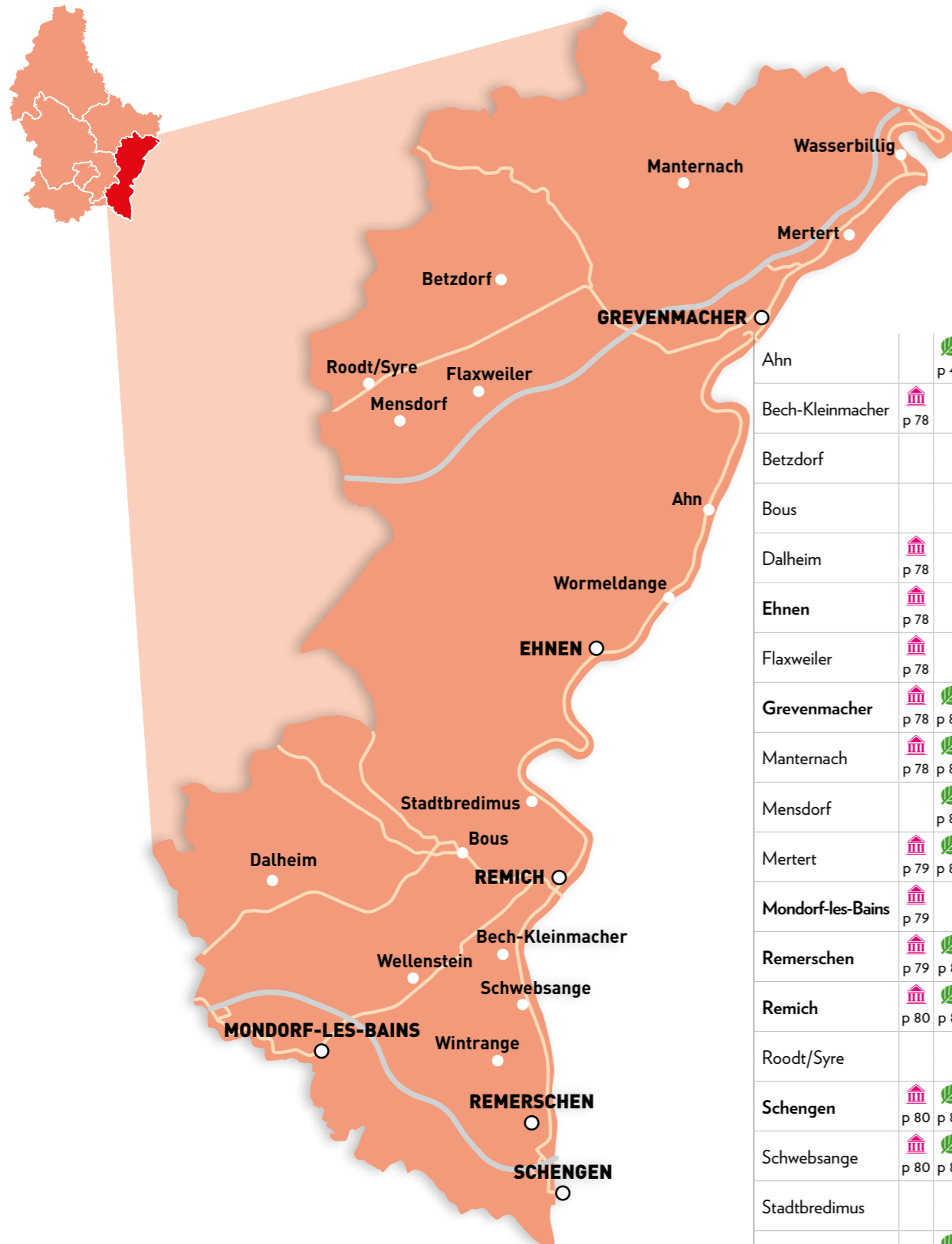

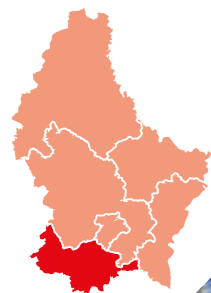

REDROCK MOUNTAIN BIKE TRAILS MOUNTAIN BIKING IN THE LAND OF THE RED ROCKS

The new RedRock Mountain Bike Trails in the Land of the Red Rocks do get the adrenalin pumping and impress bikers on a route of 167 km. The trails in the most southern region of Luxembourg lead through lush green passages, along cliffs of fiery red sandstone. Bunny-hops, wheelies, jumps – here, talent, skill, and a good sense of balance are required.

The marked trails guide bikers on the traces of Luxembourg's industrial and historical past through former open cast iron ore mines, which today have become protected nature reserves. Back in the days, the steel industry had marked not only the economical, but also the natural landscape where millions of tons of iron ore were mined. Today, nature has taken over this man-made landscape and offers breathtaking panoramic views.

The trails leading through the nature reserves „Haard“, „Ellergrohn“, „Lalléngberg“ and „Kiemerchen“, each between 25 and 37 km, can be combined with one another according to sporting ambition, either on one day or over several days. Different levels of difficulty are offered, ranging from S1 to S2+, following the German Single Trail Scale. However the trails are suited best for bikers who master the basic techniques and who have already gained first experience on the mountain bike.

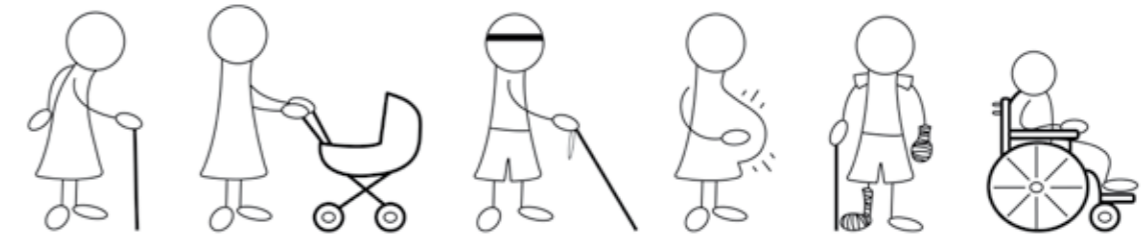
