
PLANNING YOUR DAY

At Birdsall House we aim to offer you a truly bespoke experience when planning for and enjoying your wedding day. No two weddings at Birdsall are the same and we work with you, your hopes, ideals and budgets, to create the wedding of your dreams. We want you to enjoy holding your wedding in our magical and majestic surroundings, whilst not feeling too daunted or intimidated along the way.

We are delighted to offer a planning service that is included in the charge for Birdsall House. Our address book contains a huge range of contacts from stationers to florists and jugglers, photographers, tailors, jewellers and bakers. With experience of working with caterers and suppliers, as well as couples and their families, we work with each client to make sure that your individual style and personality is reflected in your special day.









GETTING MARRIED

Whether you are looking to hold your wedding in St. Mary's Church within our grounds, hold an Indian ceremony in our Ballroom or have a more rustic festival amongst the woodland surrounding Birdsall House, we are able to offer every type of celebration. We are licensed to hold civil ceremonies within all the reception rooms of Birdsall House or how about holding your civil ceremony surrounded by stunning gardens, in the Little Temple or our 12th century Church Ruins?

St Mary's Church, Birdsall is situated within the parkland of the house and is a two minute drive away or a beautiful 10 minute stroll up our avenue of 300 year old lime trees on a sunny day. The Church holds up to 250 people and Rev. Stephen Walker is very happy to talk to couples who may wish to marry at St Mary's.











CELEBRATIONS

We have five main receptions rooms in Birdsall House that can be used separately or combined to create the perfect venue for you and your guests. Our stunning Ballroom gives an impressive and yet intimate space that can be made up to host a wedding breakfast for 120 people or a drinks reception for a few more. It is also possible to combine this room and the adjacent Oval Room to create a wedding breakfast for up to 150 guests. For larger numbers of guests a marquee, along the terrace or infront of the ruins, and overlooking the stunning gardens, gives your family and friends a day to remember.





STUNNING SURROUNDINGS

THE DINING ROOM

Our stunning Dining Room can be used for a civil ceremony or drinks reception for up to 125 guests, a seated wedding breakfast for up to 80 guests or dancing after dinner for up to 50 guests. Alternatively, why not host an intimate family dinner for up to 24 people in this room the night before your wedding?

THE LONG HALL

The Long Hall links the Dining Room and the Oval and Ballroom. You can use the Long Hall for a civil ceremony or as a quieter seating area to link in with the larger rooms of the house. Alternatively the Long Hall can host a stand up reception for up to 100 guests.

THE OVAL ROOM & BALL ROOM

The breath-taking Oval Room can be used alone for a smaller civil ceremony, reception or wedding breakfast for up to 36 people. Alternatively, enormous doors link it with the Ballroom to create a large L-shaped room that can be used for up to 250 standing guests or 150 seated guests.

DANCING IN THE GARDENS

Our beautiful gardens with views of our lakes, woodland and the Yorkshire Wolds provide the perfect setting for civil ceremonies and celebrations that can last into the night. Marquees, tipis and yurts allow you to increase the size of your party and this is where we host both evening dancing for larger parties and garden weddings.

REVELLING IN THE GARDENS

The gardens at Birdsall House are very majestic and were initially set out in 1735 by the well known garden designer Thomas Knowlton, pupil of Capability Brown. They include a series of lakes, a 12th Century Church Ruin and, in May and June, we host a very impressive display of Rhododendrons. Civil ceremonies, blessings, receptions and evening parties can be held in the extensive gardens around the house and benefit from the stunning surrounding views.









COCKTAILS & CANAPÉS

CATERING

At Birdsall House we work with a number of fantastic caterers and we ask that you use one of our five recommended caterers to provide the food for your wedding. Each caterer has worked with us at Birdsall and we know can be relied upon to design, cook and serve your guests an outstanding meal using local, fresh ingredients. They will work with you to create a bespoke menu to ensure you have exactly what you want on your big day, whilst catering for food allergies and dietary requests.

DRINKING

Why not offer your guests a cocktail or non-alcoholic mocktail on arrival at your reception? We are delighted to offer our inhouse bar for all weddings at Birdsall House. Run by The Yorkshire Bartender, a highly experienced, respected and skilled team, we offer three different drinks packages as well as the possibility of creating a completely bespoke package for your guests. We offer a wide range of cocktails, mocktails, bubbles and beer to suit every taste and budget and can work with open bars, pay bars or a hybrid of the two. It is also possible to bring your own wine for a corkage fee. We look forward to chatting over a cocktail or two to see what would work best for you.













STAYING AT BIRDSALL

We hope your guests will enjoy your wedding at Birdsall House and why not make a weekend of it with a dinner for your close family and friends the night before the wedding and a welcome brunch the morning after? We have a sumptuous Bridal Suite, with its own dressing room and bathroom (complete with double bath) where you can prepare for your wedding day. We also have five further stunning ensuite bedrooms to accommodate your wedding party. We have recently renovated all our guest bedrooms to the highest possible standard to ensure we make your stay as comfortable as possible.

For more guest accomodation nearby we work closely with Langton Hall which is two miles from Birdsall. Langton Hall can be taken exclusively and sleeps up to 49 guests in self catering accomodation. A minibus will be provided to run weddings guests between the two houses. If glamping is more your scene we are able to organise this within our stunning gardens.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

CAN I PROVISIONALLY BOOK A DATE?

We can hold a date for you for two weeks after your viewing. If we have not heard from you after two weeks we will release the date.

HOW DO I CONFIRM A BOOKING?

We require a non-refundable deposit of 50% along with a signed booking form agreeing to our Terms and Conditions.

HOW DOES OUR PLANNING SERVICE WORK?

We are here to help you achieve your perfect day and can help with sourcing new suppliers, gaining quotes or working logistics out for you. We will be there on the day to ensure everything runs to plan.

FOR CIVIL CEREMONIES, DO WE NEED TO CONTACT THE REGISTRARS?

As soon as you have decided on a date please ensure you check availability with the registrar. We are unable to contact them on your behalf. Payment for your ceremony is to be made directly with the registrars and once booked please advise us of the ceremony time.

WHEN CAN WE & OUR SUPPLIERS HAVE ACCESS TO THE VENUE?

Access for suppliers starts from 10am the day before the wedding and they must clear by 12 noon on the day after the final wedding event. For the bridal party access is very flexible and arranged with us. All preparations and deliveries are to be arranged with our wedding co-ordinator.

CAN WE PROVIDE OUR OWN CATERING?

All food, with the exception of the wedding cake and evening food, is to be provided by one of our preferred caterers. If alternative caterers are required for ethnic or religious reasons this can be arranged.

CAN WE SUPPLY OUR OWN ALCOHOL?

We run the supply of all alcohol for weddings in house. We offer four drinks packages which couples can decide to have or for a corkage fee you are able to bring your own wine and champagne. We do not allow caterers to run wedding bars.

CAN WE CHOOSE OUR OWN SUPPLIERS?

With the exception of food and alcohol you are free to choose your other suppliers, such as photographers or florists. Our team is here to help you find the right one for you.

IS THE VENUE WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE?

We have a ramp (if required) for guests with walking difficulties to get up the front steps and access is possible to all the downtairs rooms. Whilst we do not have any bedrooms that can be accessed by wheelchairs we can advise on local accommodation that is accessible.

WHAT ARE THE BAR AND MUSIC FINISH TIMES?

The bar and music must stop by midnight and guests must leave the property immediately, apart from those staying in the house

DO YOU SUPPLY A PA SYSTEM?

Yes, we have a portable PA system for you to use during the day.

WHERE CAN WE DANCE?

Parties of up to 50 can dance in the house. For larger parties we require a marquee to be in the garden for dancing. This allows you to include any additional evening guests to increase the size of your party.

ARE CANDLES AND TEA LIGHTS ALLOWED AT THE VENUE?

Naked flames are not to be used inside the house except on dining tables. Outside the house candles and tealights can be used provided they are in fireproof containers. The positioning of these must be agreed with the venue.

CAN WE HAVE FIREWORKS & LANTERNS?

Low noise fireworks and sparklers are permitted, although we do not allow Chinese lanterns.

CAN GUESTS PARK OVERNIGHT AND WHAT ABOUT TAXIS?

Yes, guests can park in the guest car park overnight. However, all cars must be removed by noon the following morning. Taxis MUST be ordered in advance of the wedding as the local firms get booked up very quickly. We can give you the taxi firm numbers to pass on to your guests.

CAN THE GIRLS WEAR STILLETTOS IN THE HOUSE?

We do not allow stillettos in the house and advise that couples warn their guests prior to the wedding.

IS THERE ADDITIONAL ACCOMMODATION NEARBY?

Langton Hall is in the next village and couples are able to book it exclusively for up to 49 guests in self catering holiday cottages. (www.langtonhall.org). Burythorpe House Hotel is 2 miles away and has 14 rooms available (www.burythorpehouse.co.uk) or we can organise glamping in our gardens for your guests.

CAN WE LAND A HELICOPTER AT BIRDSALL?

Absolutely, we have an area for landing and can liase with pilots to make the necessary arrangements.

COSTS FOR 2022

Currently we are in Corona Lockdown and it is very difficult to predict the outcome of how our supplier rates will be affected over the next 12 months. We can therefore given you a guide to our expected 2022 prices and hope that we will be able to confirm these once we have more information and life has setted a little.

Ceremony & reception in Birdsall House for 50 - 150 guests including one nights stay for the Wedding Party	£9,450
Wedding weekend at Birdsall House including Friday to Sunday exclusive use and two nights stay for the Wedding Party	£13,650

For weddings of over 50 guests dancing takes place in the garden.

All prices are inclusive of 20% VAT but this is subject to change by the Govenrment.
